

In the Hunter-Jumper world there is a large group of bits to choose from, especially for showing jumpers. But the slightest difference in how the horse holds the mouthpiece can make a huge change in the results. For this reason, Whisper Bits offer another opportunity to find what works best for you and your horse. The Whisper Bit is similar to the well-known Happy Mouth bit - but the Whisper Bit has a slightly more abrupt result while still keeping the horse very comfortable. The Whisper Bit is also a great choice for a rider's hands that might be too quick.

The Whisper D Ring Snaffle works well in the hunter and equitation ring and is a great tool when teaching beginner riders to develop good hands. The Whisper Gag Bit is also good for training some hunters. It has a slow gag effect which helps with heavier horses while training. It is also great as a mild gag with leverage in the jumper ring. The gag engagement is slower than other such bits so the horses' reaction is smoother and that makes it good for horses that might tend to over react.


